

***NEVADA-SIERRA CONNECTING POINT PUBLIC AUTHORITY GOVERNING**

BOARD: (3 vacancies) Three consumer representatives; one to fill a 3-yr. term ending June 30, 2019 and two to fill 3-yr. unexpired terms ending June 30, 2020. This authority provides for the delivery of the In-Home Supportive Services Program (IHSS) in the counties of Nevada and Sierra.
