Resolution requesting the Nevada County Transportation Commission allocate \$45,000 from Fiscal Year 2023/24 Local Transportation Fund Pedestrian/Bicycle Funding for the Combie Road Multi-Purpose Trail

Project—District II

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

FUNDING: The Combie Road Multi-Purpose Trail Project is budgeted to be funded with Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds. This project is in the current Department of Public Works 2024 Capital Improvement Plan. A budget amendment is not required and there is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) currently has \$1,304,745 in CMAQ funding programmed for Construction funding for the Combie Road Muli-Purpose Trail project. The Department of Public Works (DPW) is working on finalizing design and environmental documents for the project.

The 2023/24 Local Transportation Fund Pedestrian/Bicycle Fund has a balance of \$87,069.00 available for Nevada County to request for applicable projects.

DPW is requesting allocation of Fiscal Year 2023/24 Local Transportation Fund Pedestrian/Bicycle funding in the amount of \$45,000 to finalize design and environmental documents.
