

# RESOLUTION No. 21-168

### OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS) FOR FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) SECTION 5311 (49 U.S.C. SECTION 5311) CORONAVIRUS RELIEF AND RESPONSE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT (CRRSAA) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,221,004 FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2021

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to states through the Federal Transit Administration to support capital/operating assistance projects for non-urbanized public transportation systems under Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act (FTA C 9040.1G); and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation has been designated by the Governor of the State of California to administer Section 5311 grants for transportation projects for the general public for the rural transit and intercity bus; and


WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division desires to apply for said financial assistance to permit operation of service/purchase of capital equipment in Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division is requesting \$768,114 for operating assistance and \$452,890 for the purchase of capital assets of four paratransit vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division has, to the maximum extent feasible, coordinated with other transportation providers and users in the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors does hereby:

- 1. Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works to file and execute applications on behalf of Nevada County with the Department to aid in the financing of capital/operating assistance projects pursuant to Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act (FTA C 9040.1G), as amended.
- 2. Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works to provide additional information as the Department may require in connection with the application for the Section 5311 CRRSAA projects.
- 3. Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works to submit and approve requests for reimbursement of funds from the Department for the Section 5311 project(s).
- 4. The Board's approval will be obtained by Department of Public Works for execution of a contract and acceptance of grant funds if awarded.

Nevada County Transit Services/Nevada County Connects is a fixed route service that provides a repetitive, specific, public transit bus schedule serving the same origins and destinations along a specific route. The service is a "hub" system that departs and arrives at our central Tinloy Transit Center in Grass Valley, CA which is the main transfer point for all routes with additional transfer locations. The Gold Country Stage system connects population, commercial, and employment centers throughout western Nevada County with seven routes weekdays 6:00am-8:00pm and Saturday 7:30am-5:00pm and includes a regional route to Placer County and rural stops in Rough and Ready, Penn Valley, North San Juan, Alta Sierra and Lake of the Pines. The two-zone fare system is based on a local and outlying service area. Cash, daily pass, and monthly pass fares are available with discounts for youth, senior and disabled passengers.

Per our paratransit fleet replacement plan authorized by Resolution No. 13-149, we are to replace the current contractor owned paratransit fleet with a fleet owned by the County. This project will complete the fleet replacement and will improve price competition during future paratransit service contract procurements.

**Question 7a:** Describe what service improvements would be addressed by acquiring the equipment and or vehicle(s)?

The proposed vehicles will allow the paratransit fleet to operate more effectively in all conditions, including snow and heavy rains, through the addition of all-wheel drive vehicles.

**Question 7b:** If your agency is requesting vehicle(s) replacement, explain why the vehicle(s) needs replacement.

The proposed vehicles replace contractor owned vehicles which are significantly beyond Useful Life Benchmarks, thus replacing them will decrease maintenance costs and overall operating costs.

**Question 7c:** If the request for vehicle(s) or equipment is for service expansion, how was the need for the expansion determined?

The proposed project is the culmination of an ongoing paratransit fleet replacement plan, which entails a transition from contractor owned fleet to a county owned fleet. This plan will ultimately reduce operating costs and will increase competitive bidding for future paratransit contract services.

**Question 7d:** If funding for this project is approved, how will the surrounding community benefit?

The community will benefit from a decrease in operating costs for the paratransit service; improved reliability due to the replacement of vehicles which have exceeded useful life; improved accessibility during extreme weather through the addition of AWD vehicles and improved safety through the inclusion of on-board security camera system.
