OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADOPTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA ON-SITE WASTEWATER TREATMENTS SYSTEMS (OWTS) AND RELATED DOCUMENTS WHICH COMPRISE THE LOCAL AREA MANAGEMENT PLAN ("LAMP") APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE STATE CENTRAL VALLEY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD (CVRWQCB) ON APRIL 7, 2017

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2012, the State of California Water Resources Control Board ("SWRCB") adopted Resolution 2012-0032 which, in part, approves the Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Systems ("OWTS"). The OWTS allows Local Agencies to propose Local Area Management Plans for Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board approval, as conditional waivers of Waste Discharge Requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is required by the State of California under Assembly Bill 885 for the County of Nevada Environmental Health Department to submit a draft LAMP to the CVRWQCB by May 13, 2016 or accept Tier 1 standards; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada Board of Supervisors Resolution 17-061 authorized the County of Nevada Department of Environmental Health (NCDEH) to submit the Final Draft LAMP to the CVRWQCB for review and approval on January 24, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (CVRWQCB) Notice of Adoption Order R5-2017-0047 on April 7, 2017 approved the County of Nevada LAMP for implementation; and

WHEREAS, The CVRWQCB requires the County of Nevada Environmental Health Department to request Board of Supervisors' approval to adopt and implement the LAMP and OWTS policy by May 2018; and

WHEREAS, no substantive changes or modifications to the previously approved OWTS are proposed, no substantial changes with respect to circumstances under which the LAMP will be undertaken have occurred, and no new information triggers the need for supplemental or subsequent CEQA analysis. The LAMP has been prepared wholly within the scope of the OWTS as analyzed by the SWRCB. As such, adoption and implementation of the LAMP does not require further environmental review pursuant to the certified regulatory program or CEQA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approves the CVRWQCB adopted LAMP and authorizes the NCDEH to implement the LAMP which consists of the Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Ordinance (OWTS) and Manual by May 2018.
