Accordingly, on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, I hereby request that your Council concur with the imposition of parcel charges in the City for the 2015/16 Fiscal Year as provided in Section 25830. The proposed parcel charges for Western Nevada County are as follows:

Single Family Residence	\$29.70 per year
Multi-Family Units	\$23.14 per year
Mobile Home Park Units	\$20.72 per year
Non-residential	\$27.19 per ton

These parcel charges reflect a continuation of the temporary reduction approved in 2012 and reflects decreases in our annual operating expenses and the ability of our current reserve fund to address potential post-closure liabilities. I appreciate your consideration in this matter and anticipate your Council's acceptance of the current rates.
