## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH JUSTICE BENEFITS, INCORPORATED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,500 IN FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027, AND \$42,500 IN FISCAL YEAR 2027-2028, TOTALING \$85,000 OVER THE CONTRACT PERIOD, JULY 1, 2026, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, FOR PROVISION OF CONSULTING, TIME STUDY AND TRAINING SERVICES PERTAINING TO TITLE IV-E REIMBURSEMENT CLAIMING AND PERTAINING TO ASSISTANCE IN SECURING FEDERAL FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION FUNDS**

WHEREAS, certain programs mandated by the Federal government may be reimbursed to counties; and

WHEREAS, one of these programs is the Title IV-E Program; and

WHEREAS, the administrative processes used to gather and document all information necessary for reimbursement are complex and time extensive; and

WHEREAS, Justice Benefits, Inc. offers these services at a rate of 15% of revenue for each quarterly reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into a Professional Services Contract dated July 1, 2024, which is set to expire on June 30, 2026, adopted by Resolution 24-321.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County of Nevada and Justice Benefits, Inc. pertaining to assistance in Title IV-E reimbursement claiming and assistance securing Federal Financial participation funds for the period beginning July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2028, in the maximum annual amount of \$85,000, contingent upon the adoption of the fiscal year 2026-2027 budget, be and hereby is approved and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the County of Nevada and the Auditor -Controller is directed to encumber \$42,500 for fiscal year 2026-2027.
