SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment A02 to Agreement No. 13-20063 with the California Department of Public Health, Office of AIDS, (CDPH/OA), which amends the Scope of Work by identifying the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Number. The contract term of July 1, 2013 through March 31, 2016 and maximum amount of \$104,694 for HIV Care program (HCP) and Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) Services remains unchanged.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: CDPH/OA utilizes federal Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) funds to provide support for HIV/AIDS services in local areas. Funding is used to support personnel, operating expenses and other costs associated with the County's program. The funding cycle coincides with the HRSA funding cycle from April to March. There are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Public Health Department is funded each year by the State Department of Public Health to provide specific services in regard to HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus)/AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome) Program Services.

The HIV Care Program (HCP) consists of two (2) tiers of services. Tier One services include: primary medical care, laboratory testing, medical history taking, health screening, and prescribing and managing medications. Tier Two categories include: assistance with accessing Tier One care, support maintenance, and services related to reducing the risk of treatment failure and/or HIV transmission.

The Minority AIDS Initiative Program is designed to provide outreach and treatment education services to minority groups that may be affected by HIV disease.


The combined services of both programs ensure provision of comprehensive, ongoing health and support services to individuals with HIV/AIDS in our community service area. The goals are to: 1) minimize new HIV infections; 2) maximize the number of people with HIV infection who access appropriate care, treatment, support and prevention services; and 3) increase outreach, access to, and engagement in,

HIV/AIDS medical care services to HIV-infected minorities, who are disproportionately impacted by HIV and AIDS.

The Amendment before you today, revises the Agreement by identifying the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) Number, an administrative requirement for the implementation of the Ryan White Part B HIV Care Grant Program, ensuring that all funded contractors/subcontractors are informed of the corresponding number: CFDA Number 93.917. All other provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged.
