OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH CHILD ADVOCATES OF NEVADA COUNTY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,000, FOR THE CONTRACT PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2026, TO JUNE 30, 2027, TO PROVIDE MENTORING TO AT-RISK YOUTH THROUGH THE COURT APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act, derived from AB 1913, allocates funding aimed to curb crime and delinquency among at-risk youth; and

WHEREAS, AB 2083 called for the establishment of a county Interagency Leadership Team with the goal of supporting the delivery of prevention and early intervention services (as defined by the county's Comprehensive Prevention Plan and the Family First Prevention Services Act) for children and youth in foster care; and

WHEREAS, Child Advocates of Nevada County operates a Juvenile Justice One-to-One program, providing one-to-one mentoring by a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) for all referred at-risk youth; and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into a Professional Services Contract (PEST5323) dated July 1, 2025, which expired on June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County of Nevada and Child Advocates of Nevada County pertaining to providing mentoring to at-risk youth through the CASA program, for the contract term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount to \$65,000, be and hereby is approved, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and hereby is authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada, and the Auditor -Controller is directed to encumber \$65,000 for fiscal year 2026/27. All services are funded by Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act funds.
