OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH AEGIS TREATMENT CENTERS, LLC. FOR THE PROVISION OF A DRUG MEDI-CAL OUTPATIENT NARCOTIC TREATMENT PROGRAM FOR REFERRED CLIENTS OF THE NEVADA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$1,339,000 FOR THE CONTRACT TERM OF JULY 1, 2026 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027

WHEREAS, opioid use disorder is a challenge for our community, and the opioid death rate in Nevada County remains a significant concern; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has locations in Marysville, Grass Valley, and through telehealth that Nevada County Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) members receive Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) medication assisted treatment (MAT) and counseling; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County has opted into the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) with the Department of Health Care Services as of June 28, 2018; and pursuant to DMC-ODS, Nevada County is required to contract with an organization that provides a Narcotic Treatment Program (NTP); and

WHEREAS, this renewal contract enables Nevada County DMC members to receive NTP services locally and in neighboring counties to remain compliant with DMC-ODS requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between County of Nevada and Aegis Treatment Centers, LLC, for the provision of a DMC outpatient NTP for referred clients of the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department for the contract term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount of \$1,339,000 be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County Budget. The contract begins on July 1, 2026.
