**BACKGROUND:**

The California State Association of Counties (CSAC) represents California's 58 county governments before the California Legislature, administrative agencies and the Federal government. Each County Board of Supervisors elects one representative to serve on the CSAC Board of Directors for a one-year term of office. Counties may also elect an alternate member to serve in the regular member's absence.

Currently, Supervisor Heidi Hall is the Board representative, and Supervisor Ed Scofield is the alternate representative.

The CSAC term of office begins with its annual conference on November 14, 2022. Therefore, the Board is requested to elect a Supervisor and alternate to serve as Director on the CSAC Board for the new Association year.

Please consider reappointing Supervisor Hall as Director, and Supervisor Scofield as the Alternate to the CSAC Board of Directors for a one-year term beginning Monday, November 14, 2022.
