- b. Fuel reduction behind 16 neighboring properties out 100' from property line as highlight in yellow of Attachment
- c. See property line staking key for accurate reference points, Attachment B
- d. Fuel Reduction should consist of:
 - a. Removing sapling trees 8" and smaller
 - b. Leave proper distance of 15-20 feet between keeper trees
 - c. Remove underbrush, manzanita, buck brush, deer brush, etc.
 - d. Skirt Remaining Trees 10" feet from ground level
 - e. Remove 80% of downed debris
 - f. Nothing larger than 10" any larger leave for natural habitat
- e. Create skid trails where needed for access and removal operations
- f. Slash to be either chipped or masticated back onto County property
- g. No chip piles higher than 3-4 inch, broadcast evenly onto County property

 - b. Broadcast chip brush on site
 - c. Remove logs
 - d. Cut stumps low
 - e. Clean up debris

- e. No chip piles higher than 3-4 inch, broadcast evenly onto County property
