SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment 1 to the contract with Child Abuse Prevention Council of Western Nevada County for the provision of child abuse prevention activities in Western Nevada County to increase the contract payment rate under the current contract maximum of \$55,973 and amend Exhibit "B" Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the increase in the maximum payment rate for the term of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Funding for this agreement is from the County Children's Trust Fund and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021- Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention (ARPA-CBCAP) funding. There will be no General Funds required.

BACKGROUND: On September 12, 2023, per Resolution 23-471, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with The Child Abuse Prevention Council of Western Nevada County (CAPCWNC) to serve as a coordinating body and open forum for dealing with the multifaceted aspects of child abuse and neglect, and to improve the delivery of system services for children and families within Western Nevada County.

The Child Abuse Prevention Council of Western Nevada County (CAPCWNC) is a community council whose primary purpose is to coordinate the community's efforts to prevent and respond to child abuse through collaboration and integration of family support services. CAPCWNC is an independent, non-profit corporation governed by a board of directors. The Council encourages representation from public and private agencies, parents, consumers of services, public child welfare services, the criminal justice system, prevention and treatment services, and the larger community to plan, educate, and engage in child abuse prevention. The rate increase from \$25.19 to \$38.75 is to better reflect actual costs.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment as the activities provided are vital to child abuse prevention in Western Nevada County.
