OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 6 TO PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT NO. BFS15295 BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND PORTER SCOTT, A PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION, INCREASING THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT PRICE BY \$50,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2014, the County executed a Personal Services Contract with Porter Scott, A Professional Corporation, for legal services in connection with the lawsuit entitled *Evans, et al vs. Nevada County Sheriff's Department, et al.* (U.S. Dist. Court, E.D. Cal.), Case No. 2:13-cv-01775-TLN-DAD and the related state court action; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 14-338, the parties amended the Contract to increase the Maximum Contract Price to \$65,000; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 15-295, the parties amended the Contract to increase the Maximum Contract Price to \$140,000 and extend the term of the Contract to June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 16-323, the Contract was amended to extend the term of the Contract to June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 16-534, the contract was amended to increase the Maximum Contract Amount to \$240,000; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17-359, the Contract was amended to extend the term of the Contract to June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is necessary to pay for ongoing litigation costs, including upcoming trial expenses; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to increase the maximum contract amount by \$50,000, for a maximum contract price of \$290,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, that Amendment No. 6 to the Personal Services Contract by and between the County of Nevada and Porter Scott, A Professional Corporation, increasing the contract amount by \$50,000, for a maximum contract price of \$290,000, be and hereby is approved in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment.
