
RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH WILLOW GLEN CARE CENTER TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT PRICE FROM \$100,000 TO \$200,000 (AN INCREASE OF \$100,000), AND REVISE EXHIBIT "B", SCHEDULE OF CHARGES AND PAYMENTS TO REFLECT THE INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT PRICE FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026 (RES. 24-269)

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2024, per Resolution 24-269, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with Willow Glen Care Center to provide long term mental health and residential care to adults with mental health conditions; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their Agreement to increase the contract price from \$100,000 to \$200,000 (an increase of \$100,000) and amend Exhibit "B" Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and Willow Glen Care Center pertaining to the provision of long-term mental health and residential care to adult clients with mental health conditions increasing the maximum contract amount from \$100,000 to \$200,000 (an increase of \$100,000) for the contract term of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2026, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment on behalf of the County of Nevada.
