## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) FOR THE PROPOSITION 64 PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY GRANT PROGRAM, COHORT 4, FOR THE GRANT TERM JULY 1, 2026 TO DECEMBER 31, 2031**

WHEREAS, the People of the State of California passed Proposition 64 (Adult Use of Marijuana Act) in 2016, which legalized adult-use cannabis in California and created a dedicated cannabis tax revenue stream and directed funds to BSCC in support of government jurisdictions for local programs addressing public health and safety impacts of legalization (Revenue and Taxation Code Section 34019); and

WHEREAS, the BSCC has released a Request for Proposal for Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program, Cohort 4 for which the deadline for submittal is March 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is eligible to submit an application with the implementation of Ordinance 2538 which permits the retail sale of cannabis within the unincorporated area of the county; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County desires to participate in the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program funded through the California State and Local Government Law Enforcement Account and Administered by the BSCC and that the Sheriff's Office and the Community Development Agency wish to submit a joint application for up to \$4,500,000 in funding to be primarily focused on enforcement of illicit cannabis but also add support for youth cannabis prevention programs and Cannabis Enforcement equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application(s) for the California BSCC Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program, Cohort 4; and
2. Certifies that this agency is eligible to apply for the grant given updates to the Nevada County Code via Ordinance 2538; and
3. Agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC; and
4. Appoints the Nevada County Sheriff as the authorized designated official to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof; and
4. Authorizes the Nevada County Sheriff's Office to submit an application to the California Board of State and Community Corrections for the Proposition 64 Public Health and Safety Grant Program, Cohort 4 for the term beginning July 1, 2026 through December 31, 2031.
