RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING AUGUST 2024 AS "CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH" IN NEVADA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS Nevada County's children have a right to receive emotional and financial support from both of their parents; and

WHEREAS, Sierra Nevada Regional Department of Child Support Services "SNRDCSS" is strongly committed to promoting the health and well-being of all of Nevada County's children by ensuring co-parents pay child support on a regular and timely basis, and encouraging all parents to have a loving and supportive relationship with their children; and

WHEREAS, SNRDCSS understands that every co-parent wants to provide shelter and safety for their children but in today's economy, it takes solutions and support to make that happen; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is a leader in child support program performance in California exceeding the statewide averages in all federal performance criteria. Last fiscal year, SNRDCSS collected \$7 million in child support payments that provided greater financial security and stability for the County's children and their families; and

WHEREAS, Child Support Awareness month is a call to action for Nevada County, reminding us that every family in all their diverse shapes and sizes, has the resources to provide shelter and safety to their kids and SNRDCSS is here to provide the solutions and support to help make that happen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada proclaims August 2024 as "Child Support Awareness Month" in Nevada County.
