
RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT A1 TO AGREEMENT NO. 21-10099, KNOWN AS THE COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PERFORMANCE CONTRACT, WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES (DHCS) TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT ONE YEAR TO THE NEW TERM JULY 1, 2021, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025 AND RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA (RES 21-321)

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, per Resolution 21-321, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of Agreement 21-10099, known as the County Mental Health Services Performance Contract, between the County of Nevada and the California Department of Health Care Services for the provision of mental health program services that adhere to all program principles and satisfies the conditions and requirements of various mental health program funding streams in accordance to Welfare and Institutions Code sections 5650(a) each county shall adopt a proposed annual county mental health services performance contract for mental health services in the county; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement is to assure that the County complies with all applicable laws and regulations that pertain to the delivery of public mental health services and the conditions of funding for various mental health program funding streams; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their agreement to extend the term by one year and amend the term end date from June 30, 2024, to June 30, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that Amendment A1 to Agreement Number 21-10099 by and between the County and California Department of Health Care Services pertaining to the mandated mental health services performance contract for the term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2025, be and hereby is substantially approved in the same form attached hereto, and retroactively authorizes the Director of Behavioral Health to execute the Amendment A1 on behalf of the County of Nevada.
