SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Environmental Clearance for the 2021 Nevada County Annual Traffic Striping Project – 426639 All Districts

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: The 2021 Nevada County Annual Striping Project is proposed to be funded with Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) and Highway Use Tax Account (HUTA) funds. There is no impact to the General Fund. The project is proposed in the FY 2021/22 Road Maintenance budget.

BACKGROUND: The 2021 Nevada County Annual Traffic Striping Project consists of striping approximately 112 miles of County-maintained roads in western and eastern Nevada County. The project is scheduled for work in the summer of 2021. All work will be performed within the County's existing right-of-way. A list and map of the roads anticipated for striping are attached to this staff memo as Attachments 1 and 2, respectively.

This Department has reviewed the project for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and has identified the project as a Class I project. Class I projects consist of repair or minor alteration of an existing public facility involving negligible or no expansion of use. Therefore, the project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA, per Section 15301 (c) of the California Code of Regulations. A Notice of Exemption has been prepared for the project and, upon approval by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, will be filed with the Nevada County Clerk's Office.
