RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTIONS 24-575, 24-576, AND 25-079 TO INCLUDE REQUIRED CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (CALOES) LANGUAGE FOR ALL CALOES PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Nevada County District Attorney's Office has been awarded and accepted the CalOES Emerging Family Justice Center Grant, the CalOES Victim Witness Assistance Program Grant and the CalOES Violence Against Women Vertical Prosecution Grant; and


WHEREAS, the Subrecipient Handbook 2025 Section 1.055 requires subrecipients to obtain written proof of authority by the governing body to enter into a grant subaward; and

WHEREAS, the proof of authority must include the naming of an Official Designee to include the Grant Subaward Authorized Agents; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Subaward Authorized Agents have the authority to initiate, view, and submit applications, amendments, modifications, reports for expenditures, and progress reports; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Subaward Authorized Agents include the District Attorney, the Assistant District Attorney, and the Administrative Analyst II.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby approves the Resolution to amend Resolutions 24-575, 24-576, and 25-079 to include the California Office of Emergency Services required language and authorizing the District Attorney and the Grant Subaward Authorized Agents to execute the grant agreement, grant subaward amendments and all additional grant documents to fulfill the grant requirements.
