OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH AEGIS TREATMENT CENTERS, LLC. FOR THE PROVISION OF A DRUG MEDI-CAL (DMC) OUTPATIENT NARCOTIC TREATMENT PROGRAM (NTP) FOR REFERRED CLIENTS OF THE NEVADA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT PRICE FROM \$300,000 TO \$367,000 (AN INCREASE OF \$67,000) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019/20 (RES. 19-472; RES. 19-610)

WHEREAS, opioid abuse is a significant challenge for our community, with the rate of opioid prescriptions as well as opioid overdose emergency department visits exceeding the state rate significantly; and

WHEREAS, Aegis Treatment Centers, LLC (“Contractor”) has locations in Marysville and Roseville that Nevada County Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) beneficiaries receive Opioid Use Disorder medication assisted treatment and counselling at both sites; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County has opted into the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) with the Department of Health Care Services as of July 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to DMC-ODS, Nevada County is required to contract with an organization that provides a Narcotic Treatment Program; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor opened a medication unit in Grass Valley in May 2018 that provides a Narcotic Treatment Program; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2019, per Resolution 19-472, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorized the execution of the renewal Personal Services Contract between the County and Aegis Treatment Centers, LLC. for Nevada County DMC beneficiaries to receive Narcotic Treatment Program services locally and in neighboring counties and enable Nevada County to be compliant with DMC-ODS requirements for the contract term July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. Subsequently, the Board approved Amendment No. 1 on December 17, 2019, per Resolution 19-610 which added language and increased the Maximum Contract Price from \$138,437 to \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their agreement to increase the Maximum Contract Price from \$300,000 to \$367,000 (an increase of \$67,000) and revise Exhibit “B” Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the increase in the Maximum Contract Price.

**AMENDMENT #2 TO THE RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH
AEGIS TREATMENT CENTERS, LLC. (RES. 19-472; RES. 19-610)**

THIS AMENDMENT is dated this 28th day of April 2020 by and between AEGIS TREATMENT CENTERS, LLC., hereinafter referred to as "Contractor" and COUNTY OF NEVADA, hereinafter referred to as "County". Said Amendment will amend the prior Agreement between the parties entitled Personal Services Contract, as approved on August 27, 2019, per Resolution No. 19-472, and subsequently amended on December 17, 2019, per Resolution No. 19-610.

WHEREAS, the County has contracted with Contractor to provide Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) outpatient Narcotic Treatment Program (NTP) for referred clients of the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department, for the contract term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their agreement to increase the maximum contract price from \$300,000 to \$367,000 (an increase of \$67,000); 2) and revise Exhibit "B" Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That Amendment #1 shall be effective as of April 1, 2020.
2. That Section (§2) Maximum Contract Price shall be changed to the following: \$367,000.
3. That Exhibit "B", "Schedule of Charges and Payments", shall be revised to the amended Exhibit "B" as attached hereto and incorporated herein.
4. That in all other respects, the prior Agreement of the parties shall remain in full force and effect.
