



RESOLUTION No. 26-211

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT WITH Foothill House of Hospitality, DBA HOSPITALITY HOUSE, FOR THE ACQUISITION AND REHABILITATION OF SINGLE FAMILY HOMES TO CREATE A MINIMUM OF TWENTY BEDS OF HOUSING IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$2,756,170, FOR THE TERM OF MAY 1, 2026, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027, AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO AMEND THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/26 (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, Hospitality House is a local non-profit organization that provides emergency shelter and supportive services to Nevada County's homeless population; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2023, utilizing funding awarded by the California State Department of Health Care Services, Nevada County Behavioral Health partnered with Hospitality House to administer and implement the Behavioral Health Bridge Housing (BHBH) Program to provide interim housing and services to individuals who have a severe mental illness, or who have co-occurring severe mental illness and substance use disorders, and who are homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless; and

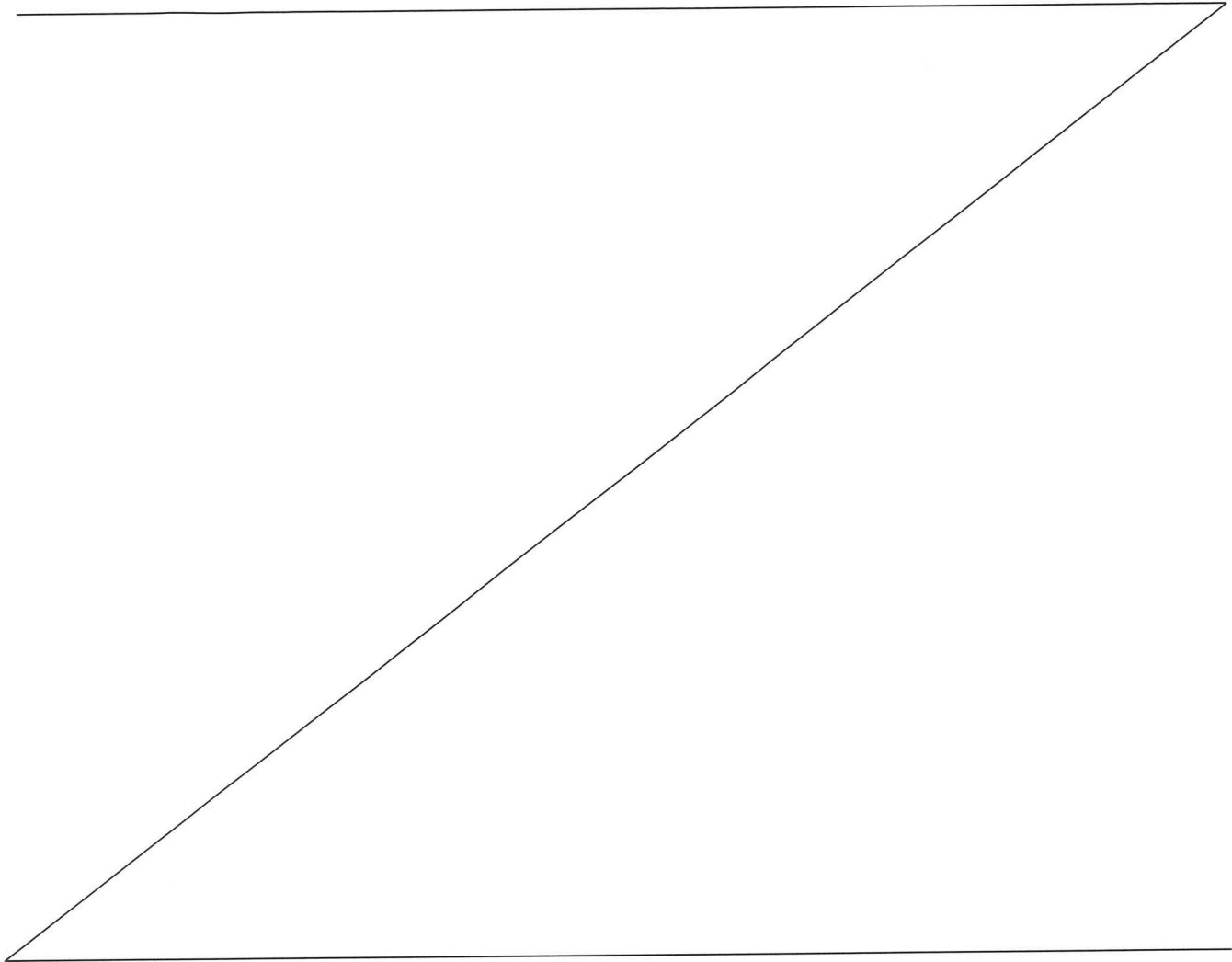
WHEREAS, the Behavioral Health Department, in cooperation with Hospitality House, applied for and was awarded additional BHBH Round 3 funds for the development of thirteen additional BHBH beds, which were completed and certified for occupancy in December 2025; and

WHEREAS, a new allocation of BHBH funds has been awarded to Nevada County to work with Hospitality House to acquire and rehabilitate single family homes to be used as housing for BHBH participants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Subgrantee Agreement by and between the County of Nevada and Foothill House of Hospitality, DBA Hospitality House, pertaining to the provision of the BHBH award of funding in the amount of \$2,756,170, for the term of May 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada, and the Auditor-Controller is directed to amend Behavioral Health budget (4/5 affirmative vote required) as follows:
