<u>BACKGROUND</u>: Every May, the Administration for Community Living leads the nation's observance of Older Americans Month (OAM). The 2024 theme is Powered by Connection, which recognizes the profound impact that meaningful relationships and social connections have on our health and well-being.

Connectedness plays a vital role in supporting independence and aging in place by combatting isolation, loneliness, and other issues. Our relationships and interactions with family, friends, colleagues, and neighbors are just some of what create social connection. Our connection with others and our community is also informed by our neighborhoods, digital environments, schools, and workplaces. Social connection is the structure, function, and quality of our relationships with others. It a critical and an underappreciated contributor to individual and population health, community safety, resilience, and prosperity.
