



RESOLUTION No. 26-225

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND PARATRANSIT SERVICES FOR THE PROVISION OF SPECIALIZED PARATRANSIT SERVICES IN WESTERN NEVADA COUNTY (SCON-00000307 OR BM422507)

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2026, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors directed staff to design and develop a Pilot River Shuttle, servicing the South Yuba River State Park recreation area at State Route Highway 49; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division and the Recreation office were directed to partner in the development of a Pilot River Shuttle; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County entered into the Paratransit Services Contract through Resolution 22-507 (SCON-00000307 or BM422507), and as amended by Resolution 25-486; and

WHEREAS, the contract has sufficient hours and resources available to support implementing a limited-time Pilot River Shuttle service; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division has developed a reasonable and fiscally constrained Pilot River Shuttle service; and

WHEREAS, there are no alternative local vendors who can independently provide the service for a lower cost per service hour; and

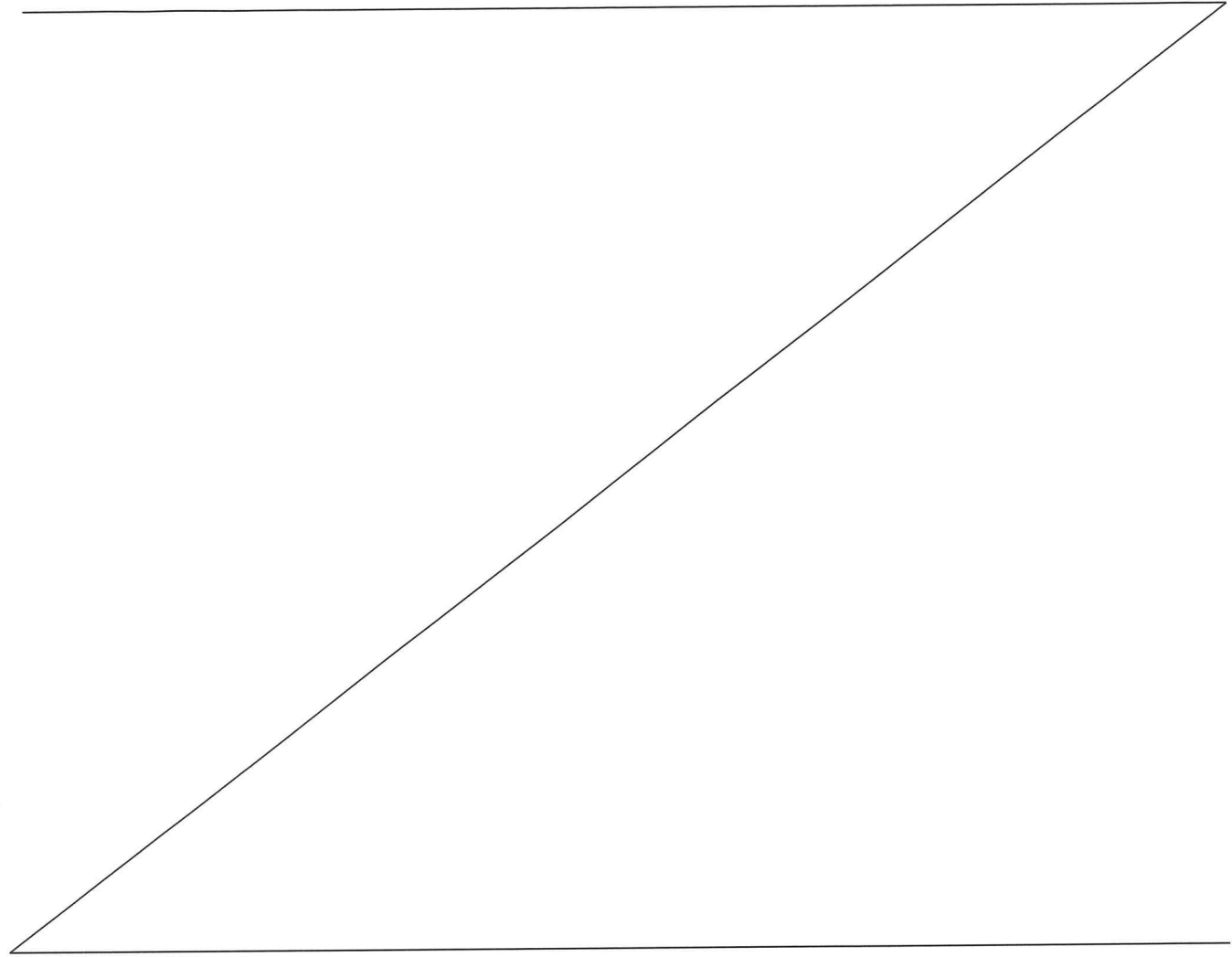
WHEREAS, Nevada County and Paratransit Services wish to amend the contract to accept the work as described in Exhibit A, Scope of Services; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient budget available in the proposed Fiscal Year 2026/27 Recreation budget in account FD1000 CC70102 PG3272000/SC21520 to fund the contract; and

WHEREAS, this contract amendment is contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Approves, contingent upon the approval of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 budget, the attached Amendment No. 2 to include the South Yuba River Pilot Shuttle Services as described in Exhibit A, Scope of Services.
2. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute, on behalf of Nevada County, the amendment between Nevada County and Paratransit Services.
