

- 1. Water Quality: drinkable, swimmable, fishable
- 2. Water Supply: groundwater protection
- 3. Biodiversity: forests, meadows, wetlands, streams, wildlife
- 4. Economy: recreation-base
- 5. Safety: wildfire, flooding (1997!)

- 7 major water bodies
