



RESOLUTION No. 17-123

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO THE WASHINGTON WATER DISTRICT (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada is in possession of a 2006 Ford F150 pick-up truck which the Fleet Manager and Purchasing Agent have determined is no longer required for county purposes, and for which the Board of Supervisors has previously, by Resolution 17-081, authorized disposal; and

WHEREAS, Section 25365 of the California Government Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to dispose of surplus property by transfer to the state or to any city, district, etc. by four-fifths vote; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Water District has a need for such a vehicle for its public purposes;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

1. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada by 4/5ths majority vote approves the donation of surplus county property, vehicle #26540, to the Washington Water District; and
2. That the Board acknowledges that the County Purchasing Agent published notice of the intended donation pursuant to Section 25365 of the Government Code and that no public comments or objections that warrant Board reconsideration were received during the publication period.
