OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE COMMUNITY CARE EXPANSION (CCE) PRESERVATION PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT, TO EXTEND THE OBLIGATION AND EXPENDITURE DATES FOR PROGRAM FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. 1 AND ANY FUTURE AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT TO PROMOTE PRESERVATION OF ADULT AND SENIOR CARE FACILITIES IN NEVADA COUNTY SERVING LOW-INCOME RESIDENTS

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2021, Governor Gavin Newsom signed AB 172 which created the Community Care Expansion (CCE) Preservation program aimed at preserving adult and senior care facilities that serve Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment (SSP) and Cash assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI) applicants as a diversion from homelessness for seniors and persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada was awarded a total of \$418,403 for the purpose of funding operating subsidy payments and capital projects addressing critical repairs or upgrades with the goal of preventing closures and preserving beds in existing facilities; and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2023, per Resolution 23-577, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved funds in the total amount of \$418,403, to promote preservation of adult and senior care facilities in Nevada County serving low-income residents; and

WHEREAS, the County is in receipt of Amendment No. 1 to the CCE Preservation program funding agreement to extend the dates for obligation and expenditure of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada that Amendment No. 1 to the CCE Preservation program funding agreement to extend the dates for obligation and expenditure of funds to promote preservation of adult and senior residential care facilities serving low-income residents, is approved, and authorizes the Housing and Community Services Director to execute Amendment No. 1 and any future amendments to the program funding agreement.
