**GET READY**

SIGN UP FOR EMERGENCY ALERTS
Sign up for CodeRED to receive critical updates during an emergency.
ReadyNevadaCounty.org/EmergencyAlerts

KNOW YOUR ZONE
Know your evacuation zone. During a wildfire, law enforcement may issue evacuation warnings or orders by zone.
Find your zone at: Protect.Genasys.com

EVACUATION ROUTES
Identify and familiarize yourself with your evacuation routes. Download, save, and print Evacuation Zone Maps.

GO-BAGS
Assemble Go-Bags for yourself and your household. Include enough supplies to last at least three days, such as prescriptions, medications, and copies of important documents.

PREPARE PETS & ANIMALS
Have a plan for evacuating pets and animals. Make sure they have fitted collars with identification. Store vaccination records and proof of ownership in your Go-Bag.

What Do I Need in My Go-Bag?

☐ 3-day supply of food

☐ 3 gallons of water per person

☐ Map with evacuation routes

☐ Assistive and medical devices

☐ Batteries and chargers

☐ Battery powered or hand-crank radio

☐ Change of clothing

☐ Closed toe shoes

☐ Prescription glasses/contacts

☐ Eye protection

☐ N95 mask

☐ Spare keys for your house & car

☐ Credit cards, cash, or checks

☐ Flashlight or headlamp

☐ Sanitation supplies & personal hygiene products

☐ First aid kit

☐ Copies of important documents

☐ Photos of family members
