## **<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>**: Adopt the resolution

**<u>FUNDING</u>**: Funding in the amount of \$225,000 has been budgeted for Fiscal Year 2024/25 and impacts the Sheriff's Office Operations budget. These services are mandatory.

**BACKGROUND:** The Placer County Sheriff's Office currently provides pathology services for the County of Nevada. Deaths under certain circumstances require the services of a Forensic Pathologist to perform autopsies and/or medical chart reviews to determine the cause of death. Nevada County does not have a morgue, nor does the Sheriff's Office employ a forensic pathologist, as the cost would be prohibitive. Our neighboring county, the County of Placer, does have a morgue and employs two forensic pathologists.

The County of Nevada has found it prudent to contract for pathology services with the County of Placer. We have been very happy with their services, as their forensic pathologists are experienced and reputable. Placer County increased their pricing and changed the pricing structure in Fiscal Year 2023/24. The pricing rates were increased by 5% for Fiscal Year 2024/25. The amount paid by Nevada County will be a minimum of \$120,000 billed quarterly. However, as the billing structure is no longer based on the number of cases but rather on a menu of services specified in Exhibit B to the Agreement, if in any quarter Nevada County uses services in excess of the quarterly allotment of \$30,000, then additional pricing/charges will be incurred. The total maximum contract of \$225,000 provides a contingency in the event that additional services are required during the fiscal year.

The contract terms allow for two one-year options to renew the Agreement. Renewal terms include a five percent (5%) increase for each year the Agreement is extended.
