SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of an amendment to the revenue agreement with the County of Glenn for the provision of Telephone Triage Services for Glenn County Adult System of Care (ASOC) and Children's System of Care (CSOC), and crisis calls to increase the maximum contract price from \$148,500 to \$163,305 (an increase of \$14,805) for the term of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027. (RES. 24-544)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: This is a revenue agreement whereby Glenn County pays Nevada County Behavioral Health Department a monthly rate as full payment for each full month during which Telephone Triage Services are provided. There are no county general funds required.

BACKGROUND: On October 22, 2024 per Resolution 25-544, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of the Professional Services Contract between the Counties of Nevada and Glenn for the provision of telephone triage services for the Glenn County Adult and Children's Systems of Care for Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder referrals and crisis calls.

It is respectfully recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve this Amendment No. 1 increasing the contract max to include a cost increase for the services provided to Glenn (increase in revenue for Nevada County) to the agreement, which serves to strengthen and promote the mutual working relationship between Glenn and Nevada Counties. In addition, this agreement will provide needed revenue for the Behavioral Health Department that will support the overall triage program.
