OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE COUNTY OF PLACER FOR THE PROVISION OF TELEPHONE TRIAGE SERVICES FOR PLACER COUNTY ADULT SYSTEM OF CARE (ASOC) AND CHILDREN'S SYSTEM OF CARE (CSOC) IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT PAYABLE OF \$1,868,150 FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2026, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028

WHEREAS, the Counties of Placer and Nevada wish to continue their mutually beneficial arrangement whereby Nevada County Behavioral Health agrees to provide telephone triage services for Placer County Adult System of Care (ASOC) and Children's System of Care (CSOC) with regard to mental health referrals for children, youth, and adults, as well as telephone answering services for after-hours CSOC child welfare calls and emergency calls; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County will continue to provide telephone triage services for Placer County with regard to Adult Protective Service referrals; Public Guardian referrals; Mental Health referrals for children, youth and adults; Substance Use Disorder referrals for children, youth, and adults; and 5150 referrals for children, youth and adults; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this renewal revenue Contract, Placer County will reimburse Nevada County Behavioral Health quarterly for the provision of these telephone triage services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and County of Placer pertaining to Nevada County Behavioral Health Department providing telephone triage services for the Placer County ASOC and CSOC, for the contract term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028, in the maximum amount of \$1,868,150 be and hereby is approved, and that the Director of Nevada County Behavioral Health be and is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada.
