

Storm Vegetation Mitigation Efforts

- **Community Green Waste Events**
 - Partnership with Fire Safe Council of Nevada County & CAL FIRE
- **Contract Awarded to Remove Debris from 70 Miles of County Maintained Roads**
- **Eastern County Green Waste Events Scheduled for Summer**
- **WM Green Waste Free Drop Off Days May 22nd and June 5th**



CAL FIRE Grant

- **Grant funding provided by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's Wildfire Prevention Grants Program**
- **Grant made possible through proactive work and communication from CAL FIRE staff**
- **Over \$11.9 million in grant funding from CAL FIRE for proactive vegetation mitigation projects over the last 4 years**
- **Results of these efforts:**
 - Vastly improves ingress/egress route safety
 - Increases safety and resiliency of both public and private property
 - Establishes strategic fuel breaks
 - Drastically reduces fire fuels overall
 - Protects life and property



CAL FIRE Grant

\$950,000 Grant


- County maintained road debris removal - **\$400,000**
- Private road debris removal – direct support - **\$310,000**
- Eastern County Green Waste Events - **\$30,000**
- Western County Green Waste Events - **\$50,000**

Private Road Support

- Aimed at addressing resource gaps for removal and/or processing of vegetation along private roadways
- Direct outreach to impacted communities
- Leveraging Firewise Communities, Road Associations & Community Leaders

 - Sawyer work
 - Chipping
 - Green waste hauling
 - And similar supportive programming
