**SUBJECT:** **Resolution to Award a Contract for the 2017 Western County Bridge Project - County Contract No. 224031 and Amending the Fiscal Year 2016/17 Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Budget – 4/5 Affirmative Vote Required (Districts 2 and 4)**

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached resolution to award the contract to Q & D Construction, Inc.

**FUNDING:** Project impacts the Fiscal Year 2016/17 Capital Improvement Project (CIP) budget and is funded with Federal Highway Bridge Program (HBP) and State Exchange funds. A budget amendment has been prepared for consideration. There is no impact on the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** On March 14, 2017 the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 17-116 approving the bidding documents and specifications for the 2017 Western County Bridge Project. The project includes the construction and rehabilitation of bridges at three locations, including McCourtney Road at Rock Creek, Garden Bar Road at Little Wolf Creek (Sanford Crossing), and Garden Bar Road at Little Wolf Creek (Railcar Crossing). The resolution also instructed the Purchasing Division to advertise for bids.

On April 20, 2017 bids were opened and three (3) contractors submitted bids:

1	Q & D Construction, Inc.	\$2,555,075
2	Viking Construction	\$2,875,099
3	Steelhead Inc.	\$2,940,624

Staff recommends awarding to the low bidder Q & D Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$2,555,075. The total amount to be encumbered is \$2,810,582.50 which includes a 10% contingency. Construction is scheduled to begin in June 2017, and will be completed within 110 working days as allowed for in the contract.
