OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO SIGN THE INVITATION TO BID, AND THE PURCHASING AGENT TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR THE 2026 EASTERN NEVADA COUNTY STRIPING PROJECT, COUNTY PROJECT 426646 - DISTRICT V

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to re-stripe approximately 9 miles of Eastern County maintained roadways as a routine maintenance and safety measure; and

WHEREAS, under section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, Class 1 projects consisting of the maintenance or minor alteration of existing public facilities are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, bidding documents have been prepared to accomplish this work; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works may make adjustments to the roadways listed as necessary; and

WHEREAS, this project is budgeted and will be funded by Road Rehabilitation and Maintenance Act (RMRA), within Road Engineering; and

WHEREAS, the project specifications and cost estimate for this project have all been completed. The Engineer's estimate is \$46,500.75, plus a 10% contingency of \$4,650.08 for a total not to exceed contract of \$51,150.83; and

WHEREAS, construction is scheduled to begin in June 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorizes the Public Works Department to proceed with 2026 Eastern Nevada County Annual Striping Project under a categorical exemption from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
2. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign the Invitation to Bid.
3. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the 2026 Eastern Nevada County Annual Striping Project.
4. Authorizes the Public Works Director to incorporate any final changes into the bid documents before advertising for bids.
