SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment A01 to the renewal Agreement Number 16-10379 with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) pertaining to the Nevada County Public Health Department, referred to as the Local Health Jurisdiction (LHJ), serving as an Enrollment Site for the AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) which adds Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Assistance Program enrollment services and extends the contract term an additional year for a revised term of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020 in the maximum amount of \$0.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: There are no funds associated with this "Site" Agreement, as the funding to support department case management/administrative costs of the ADAP enrollment screening/certification process are obtained under a separate Agreement with the State. There no County general fund dollars or match required in this Agreement.

BACKGROUND: Per Resolution 17-111, the Board of Supervisors approved Standard Agreement No. 16-10379 with the California Department of Public Health. Organizations receiving allotted AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) funding and serving as an LHJ enrollment site must also enter into an additional California Department of Public Health agreement which outlines and requires adherence to procedures and eligibility guidelines pertaining to administering ADAP.

ADAP was designed to help low-income individuals access and maintain HIV Prescription drug coverage. Federal and State law requires that ADAP can only be used after all other payer options are exhausted.

Nevada County currently receives funding for activities pertaining to the provision of ADAP client enrollment services. All LHJs receiving ADAP funding must also enter into these zero dollar

California Department of Public Health formal Enrollment Service Site Agreements. The Agreement outlines and ensures that Enrollment Sites abide by the most current Enrollment Procedures and Guidelines for Determining ADAP Eligibility.

Pursuant to this amendment, Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) Assistance Program enrollment services will be added to the services of LHJs, as well as community based organizations and hospitals throughout the State of California. This amendment will also extend the contract term an additional year.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment as it will allow the Nevada County Public Health Department to continue to serve as the enrollment site to administer the AIDS Drug Assistance Program with additional enrollment services related to the PrEP Assistance Program.
