
RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE-AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANT (EMPG-ARPA) FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FUNDED THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,739 WITH A 100% MATCHING FUND REQUIREMENT FOR USE DURING THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023

WHEREAS, the U.S Department of Homeland Security is funding a grant through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to assist state, local, and tribal governments to enhance their capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or man-made; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County's application was approved by the California Emergency Management Agency on October 11, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada hereby directs:

- 1. That the County of Nevada accept the grant in the amount of \$60,739 for the grant period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023.
- 2. That the Director of Emergency Services, County Executive Officer, and Assistant County Executive Officer are authorized to fulfill the requirements of the FY 21 EMPG-ARPA.
- 3. That the Auditor-Controller deposit grant funding in the amount of \$60,739 into the Emergency Management Budget 0101-20702-414-1000/446700 as funding is received.
