SUBJECT: Resolution to award the contract for Destruction of Seven (7) Groundwater

Monitoring Wells for the Penn Valley Sewer Zone to Arsenal Well Drilling Inc. for a total amount of \$53,950 plus a 10% contingency for a total of

\$59,345 – District IV

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: 2025 Groundwater Monitoring Wells Destruction will be funded by Penn Valley Sewer Zone 6, which has sufficient funds in the fiscal year 25/26 budget.

BACKGROUND: Nevada County Sanitation District No. 1 (District) plans to destroy seven (7) ground water monitoring wells as part of the decommissioning of its Penn Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant. On September 23, 2025, the District adopted Resolution SD25-007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the Well Destruction. Bids were opened on October 23, 2025, and the bidders are listed below:

Bidder	Total Bid
1. Arsenal Well Drilling, Inc	\$ 53,950.00
2. Living Water Well Drilling	\$ 96,500.00

It is recommended that the contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Arsenal Well Drilling, Inc at the bid price of \$53,950.00 plus a 10% contingency for a total of \$59,345.00. Work is expected to begin as soon as the contract is in place.
