SUBJECT: Resolution approving a contract with up to four (4) contract renewals with NV5, Inc. for on-call engineering support services at solid waste facilities for the fiscal year 2026/27 in an amount not to exceed \$285,852, contingent upon adoption of the fiscal year 2026/27 budget and authorizing the Purchasing Agent to execute the contract (District IV and V)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

FUNDING: Funding is included in the proposed fiscal year 2026/27 Solid Waste budget and is contingent upon adoption of the fiscal year 2026/27 County budget. Funding is provided by parcel charge assessment, and no budget amendment is needed. There is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: Nevada County maintains two closed landfill sites; the McCourtney Road Landfill (MRL) in Western Nevada County and the Hirschdale Landfill near Truckee. The County requires engineering support services on an “as-needed” basis to oversee and facilitate monitoring and testing activities, prepare technical reports and to aid with design, materials testing and construction engineering on capital projects. On March 25, 2024, the Purchasing Division released a request for qualifications for on-call engineering support services for solid waste facilities. NV5, Inc. was selected by staff as the top-ranked firm.

Continual and ongoing engineering support services are required on an as-needed basis at Nevada County solid waste facilities. The current agreement expires on June 30, 2026. Staff recommends approval of the contact with up to four (4) contract renewals in the amount not to exceed \$285,852 for the period of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027 contingent upon adoption of the fiscal year 2026/27 budget.
