SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the acceptance of Federal Aviation Administration

Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG) in the amount of \$516,296 to fund the reconstruction of Ramp 4 taxilanes stage 2, crack repair Ramp 4 taxilanes and reconstruction of Ramp 4 access road at the Nevada County Airport

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

FUNDING: The total cost of the reconstruction of Ramp 4 taxilanes stage 2 is estimated at \$746,800. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is expected to fund 90% of the cost, or \$516,296 and the remaining cost 10% of the cost, or \$230,504 will be funded by the Airport Enterprise Fund. This match is planned for and included in the department's FY 25/26 budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Airport is responsible for maintaining the airport facilities in a safe and serviceable condition in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration Grant Assurances. Resolution 23-600, approved on December 5, 2023, authorized the application for both federal and state grants for the Ramp 4 taxilane and access road design project. The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 24-495 on September 10, 2024, accepting the FAA grant in the amount of \$83,250 for funding the design of reconstructing the Ramp 4 taxilane and access road. The Airport's engineering consultant has completed the design and engineering of the pavement reconstruction for the Ramp 4 taxilane and access road design project.

On March 11, 2025, Resolution 25-090 approved the construction bid documents, plans and specification for the solicitation of bids for the Ramp 4 rehabilitation at the Nevada County Airport and authorized the Airport Manager to apply for the FAA grant. The Nevada County Airport is anticipating receiving the Airport Infrastructure Grant in the amount of \$516,296 from the FAA. We are requesting permission to accept the grant once the notification is received as the timeframe for acceptance is very short. We are also requesting that the Director of Facilities Management be authorized to execute this Grant and any actions necessary for the Federal Aviation Administration.
