- \$39 million General Fund
- More than 308 employees (FTE)

- Strengthening community partnerships.

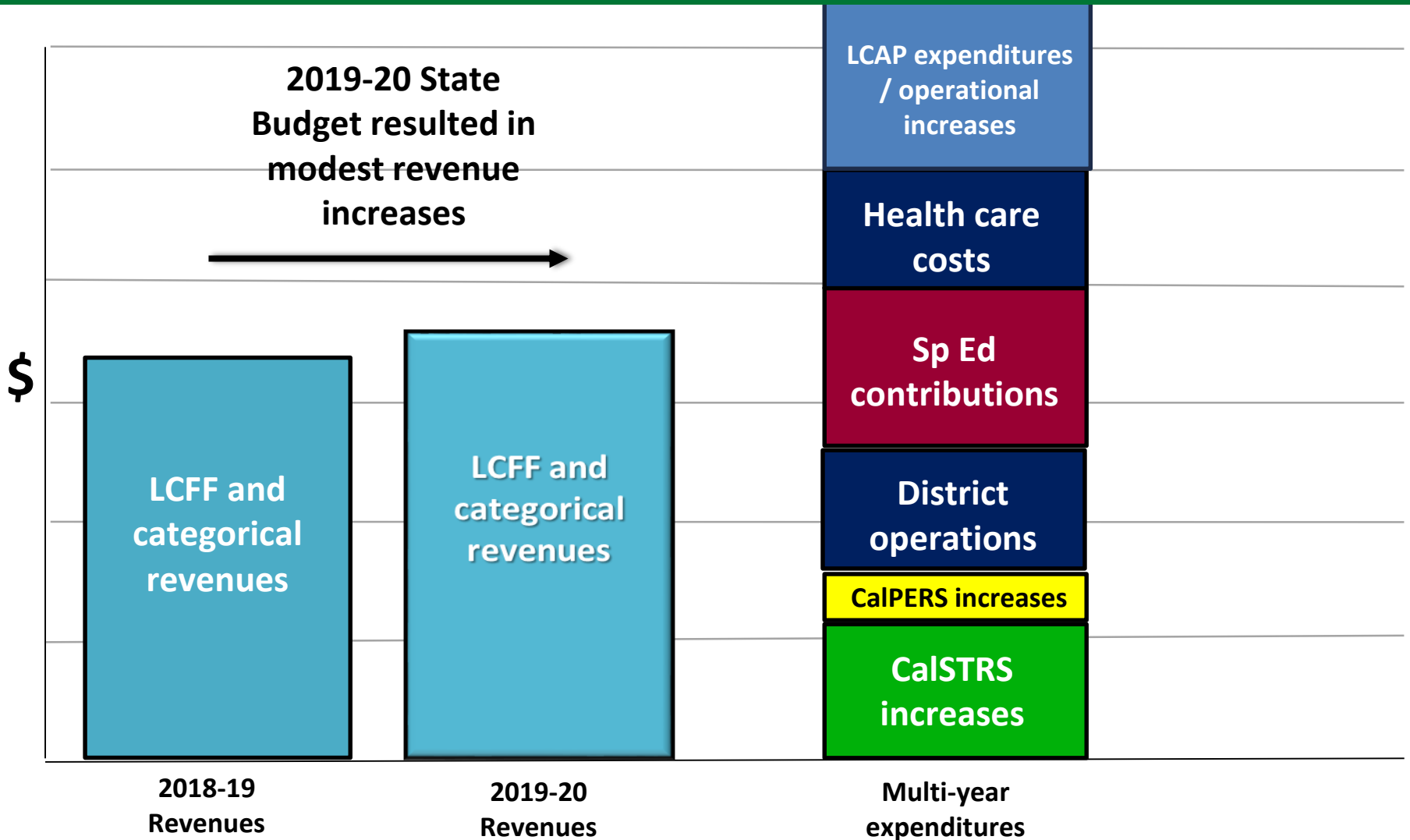

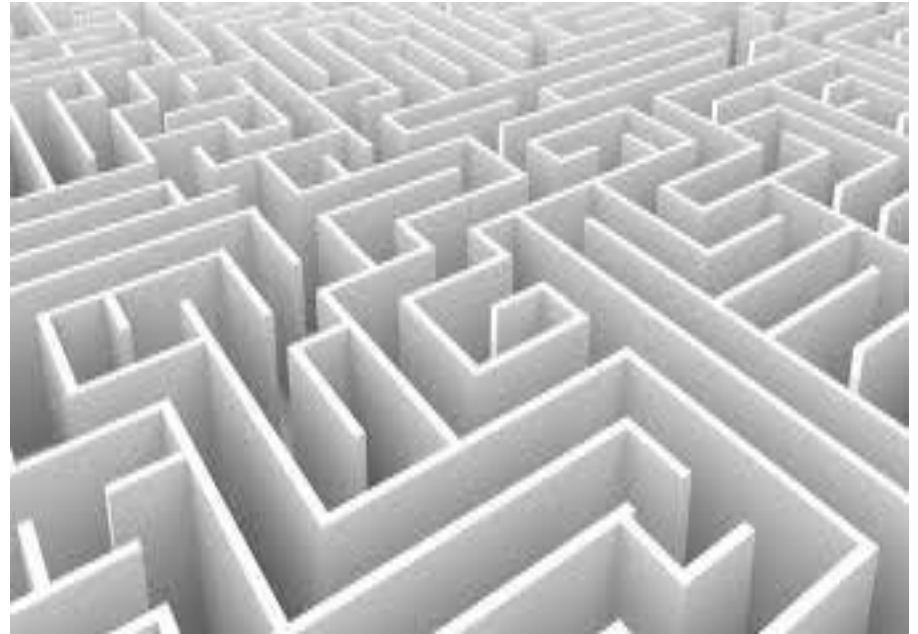
