SUBJECT: Resolution to Approve Bidding Documents for the Gold Country

Stage Bus Stop Improvements Project – 889816 District III

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution to approve Bidding Documents for the Gold Country Stage Bus Stop Improvements Project.

<u>**FUNDING:**</u> Project will be funded by California State Prop 1B Public Transportation Modernization Improvement and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) FY10/11 – 14/15 grant funds. There is no impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** On January 8, 2019, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved an environmental clearance for the Gold Country Stage Bus Improvements Project at Olympia Park Road.

This project will modernize and enhance accessibility for buses, providing a new bus stop turnout near the existing stop location at Olympia Park Road, adjacent to the Glenbrook Center. The bus stop turnout will include a bus shelter, bench and sidewalk access, providing American Disability Act (ADA) accessibility. Moving the bus stop street-side will improve safety by limiting travel through parking lots and improve route performance by increasing the speed and accessibility of the stop. The existing bus stop within the parking area at the shopping center will be removed by County staff. The project is consistent with the Nevada County Transit Services Bus Stop Policy approved by the Transit Services Commission on November 14, 2018.

The project plans, specifications, and cost estimate for this project have been completed. The engineer's estimate is \$80,000. The bid opening date is scheduled for May 18, 2021, with construction scheduled to begin in summer 2021.
