



RESOLUTION No. 26-221

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO CLOSE THE ADOPT-A-ROAD FUND (FD5671) AND TRANSFER THE BALANCE OF THE UNCLAIMED FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND (FD1000)

WHEREAS, the voluntary Adopt-a-Road program was established under Resolution 91-293, to engage citizens and organizations in litter clean-up on Nevada County maintained roads; and

WHEREAS, participants in the program were previously required to submit deposits, which were held in the Adopt-a-Road fund (FD5671); and

WHEREAS, the program was later revised to eliminate the deposit requirement, and no additional deposits have been collected since that time; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that unclaimed funds remain in the Adopt-a-Road Fund (FD5671); and

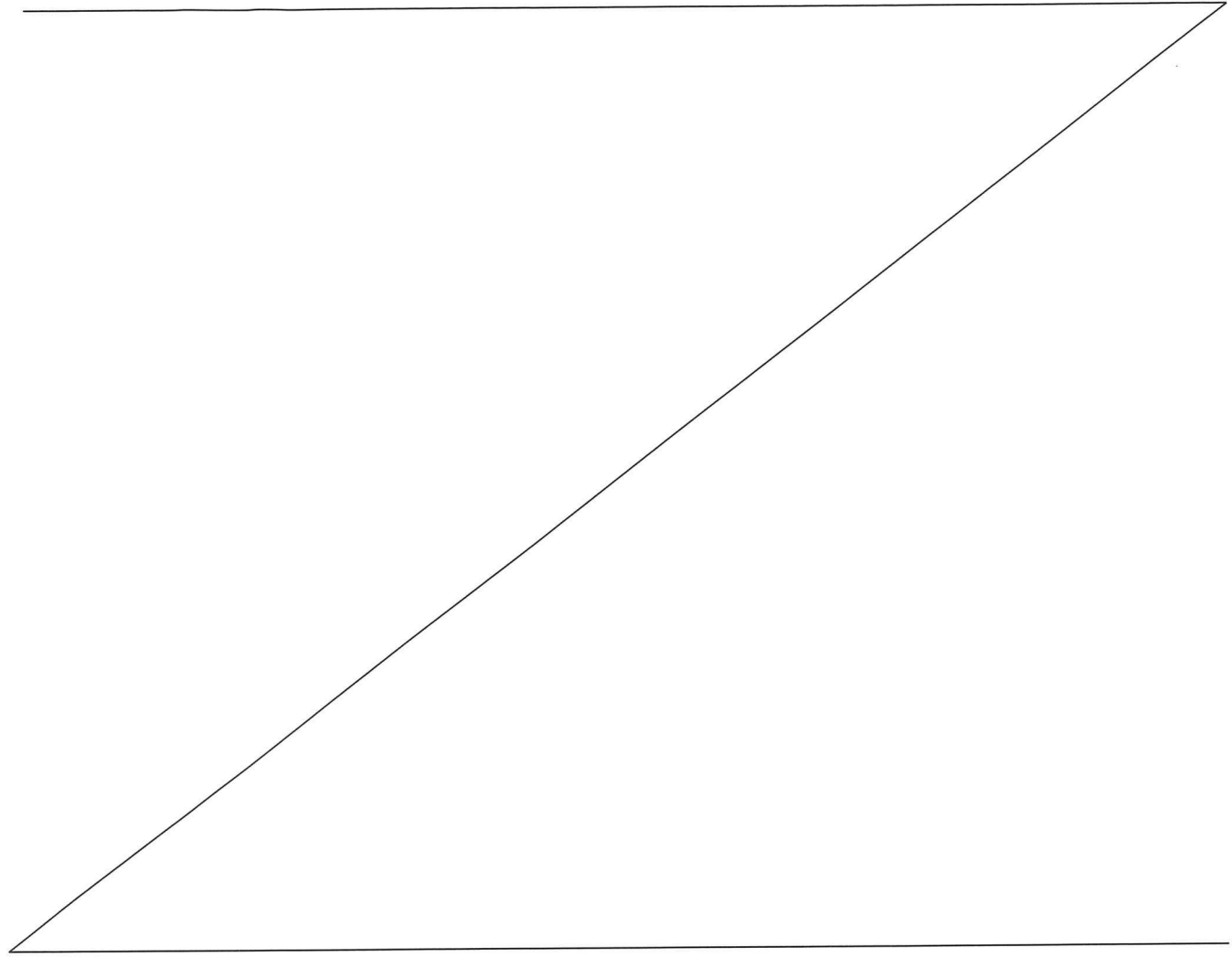
WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code, Sections 50050-50057, notice has been provided, and no valid claims have been received; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Agency desires to declare the remaining unclaimed funds as surplus, transfer them to the General Fund (FD1000), and close the Adopt-a-Road Fund (FD5671); and

WHEREAS, the proposed disposition of funds is summarized in Exhibit "A", attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California:

1. Declares the unclaimed funds in the Adopt-a-Road Fund (FD5671) to be surplus.
2. Authorizes and directs the Auditor-Controller to transfer the remaining balance to the General Fund (FD1000).
3. Authorizes the closure of the Adopt-a-Road Fund (FD5671).
