The Governing Board shall establish all policy; procedural rules for expenditure and obligation and conditions on the use of funds; enter into and administer contracts and sub grants for the purpose of carrying out the intent and functions of the OAA and any other pertinent grant programs; adopt the area plan and annual budget; and perform all its responsibilities in accordance with OAA, the Older Californians Act (OCA), and all other pertinent laws, regulations and rules.

The Governing Board shall consist of 17 members: two appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Nevada County; one of the appointees shall be a member of the Board of Supervisors and the other shall be appointed from a list of candidates screened and recommended by the County Commission or Council on Aging. Non-Supervisor Member shall serve a 2-yr. term. Supervisor shall serve 1-yr. term.

A4AA Governing Board meets the second Tuesday of each month in Sacramento.
