SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the purchase of a Gantry Crane Assembly for the Sanitation maintenance shop in the amount of \$11,496.20 and a Safety Platform for the Lake of the Pines Wastewater Treatment Facility in the amount of \$29,996.50 – District II

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution

FUNDING: Funding of \$41,492.70 for these two fixed assets for Fiscal Year 2025/26 is included in the Sanitation District Budget for Zone 2 Lake of the Pines. There is no impact to the general fund.

BACKGROUND: The Sanitation District requests approval to purchase two capital assets; a gantry crane assembly and a safety platform.

The gantry crane with dual beam trolley and electric chain hoists is for the Sanitation maintenance shop. The existing crane for the Lake of the Pines maintenance shop has failed and is not repairable. The replacement gantry crane assembly has been located through Global Industrial, an OMNIA Partners Public Sector Contract No. R211402 and a sole source provider. The purchase of this new Gantry crane assembly requires the approval of a capital asset by the Board of Directors. The total cost of the new equipment is \$11,496.20.

The safety platform will assist staff with balancing the loads of dried solids at the Lake of the Pines Wastewater Treatment Facility. The current process is time consuming and exposes operators to fall hazards and injury. In order to address this problem, the platform can be utilized to complete the work in safe manner. Staff has identified a permanent platform that will meet the needs of the District through Global Industrial. Global Industrial utilizes OMNIA Partners Public Sector Contract No. R211402 as sole source provider. The purchase of the safety platform as a capital asset requires approval by the Board of Directors. The cost of the new platform is \$ 29,996.50.
