About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the "livability" of Nevada County. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 518 residents of Nevada County collected from September 12th, 2023 to October 24th, 2023. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 4% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2023 survey was 18%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Nevada County.





How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Nevada County's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Nevada County residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Nevada County's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Nevada County's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered after the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to or during the pandemic. This may impact how your County's 2023 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

Trends over time

Trend data for Nevada County represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines*. Deviations from stable trends over time represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs, or public information may have affected residents' opinions. Changes between survey years have been noted with an arrow and the percent difference. If the difference is greater than six percentage points between the 2017 and 2023 surveys, the change is statistically significant.

* In 2020, The NCS survey was updated to include new and refreshed items. Consequently, some of the trends may be impacted due to wording modifications that could have potentially altered the meaning of the item for the respondent.

Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within Nevada County were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Nevada County was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve Nevada County households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of Nevada County boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. Each address identified as being within county boundaries was further identified as being within one of the 5 areas. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 3,000 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on September 12th, 2023 and the survey remained open for six weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. Lastly, all selected households received a final reminder postcard. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

About 4% of the 3,000 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,894 households that received the invitations to participate, 518 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 18%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for Nevada County survey is no greater than plus or minus four percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (518 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by Nevada County. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all county residents and became available on October 10th, 2023. The survey remained open for two weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in Nevada County. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, housing tenure, and area. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Study Limitations

All public opinion research is subject to unmeasured error. While the methodologies employed for this survey were designed to minimize this error as much as possible, these other sources of potential error should be acknowledged, and can include non-response error, coverage error, recall bias and social desirability bias. Non-response error arises when those who were selected to participate in the survey did not do so, and may have different opinions or experiences that survey responders. For general resident surveys, where the results are meant to be generalized to the entire adult population living in households, the mailing lists based on the Delivery Sequence File from the United States Post Office may exclude certain types of housing units, such as those in multi-family buildings where mail is addressed to a named resident at the address rather than to a specific unit or where residents only receive their mail at a post office box and the geographic location of a residence cannot be determined, there may be a coverage error, although for most locations, this is minimal. Respondents may not perfectly remember their experiences in the past year (such as participation in social or civic events), and for some survey items they may answer in ways they think cast their responses in a more favorable light (recall bias and social desirability bias).

Key Findings

Nevada County continues to be a highly desirable and engaging community, yet participants emphasize the importance of fostering inclusivity.

Nevada County as a place to live received positive ratings from about 9 in 10 residents. A similarly high proportion, roughly 8 in 10 survey participants, were pleased with Nevada County as a place to raise children. About three-quarters also approved of the county as a place to retire. In addition, most respondents would recommend living in Nevada County to others (82%) and planned to remain in the county for the next five years (87%). The high quality of life experienced in Nevada County is likely linked to residents' positive perceptions of community engagement opportunities. Many related survey items received strong ratings, including opportunities to volunteer (85%), opportunities to participate in social events and activities (79%), and opportunities to participate in community matters (77%), all of which were higher than the national benchmark.

However, survey questions related to inclusivity earned relatively lower ratings, indicating an opportunity for growth. While 7 in 10 participants felt the county does an excellent or good job at making all residents feel welcome, only about half provided positive feedback regarding the county's efforts in valuing/respecting residents from diverse backgrounds. Similarly, the county's performance in attracting people from diverse backgrounds and taking care of vulnerable residents received favorable reviews from just 4 in 10.

Residents experience a strong sense of safety in Nevada County but indicate concerns about wildfire preparedness.

Virtually all respondents reported feeling very or somewhat safe in their neighborhood during the day (95% very or somewhat safe) and in Nevada County's downtown/commercial area during the day (90%). About 8 in 10 favorably rated the overall feeling of safety in the county as a whole and reported feeling safe from violent crime and property crime. Each of these scores were in line with comparison communities across the nation.

However, only about one-third of residents felt safe from fire, flood, or other natural disasters. In series of questions unique to Nevada County, these results were further explored. When asked about emergency preparedness, about 9 in 10 residents agreed that they were prepared for wildfire evacuation. Nearly all respondents indicated that they were signed up for emergency alerts, but when asked rate their level of concern related to wildfire risk in their neighborhood, two-thirds were very concerned about the ability to receive emergency alerts during a wildfire (e.g., loss of power, loss of cell service, etc.). About 8 in 10 also indicated that they were very concerned about the ability to find or renew fire insurance. Results revealed that the CAL FIRE website, friends and family/word of mouth, social media, and ReadyNevadaCounty.org were most heavily relied upon as wildfire preparedness resources.

The local economy is strong but poses challenges to community affordability.

When asked about which general aspects of the community the County should focus on in the next two years, 9 in 10 respondents identified overall economic health as an area of priority. In comparison, about half of residents gave positive ratings to the quality of economic health in Nevada County, identifying it as a potential opportunity for growth. A strong majority of respondents gave favorable assessments to Nevada County as a place to visit (92%) and to the vibrancy of its downtown/commercial areas (75%), both higher than the national average. The overall quality of business and service establishments in the county was scored positively by about three-quarters, on the rise since 2017. Additional survey items related to Nevada County businesses also trended upward since the previous survey, including economic development (from 33% in 2017 to 44% in 2023) and shopping opportunities (from 43% to 54%).

In terms of income, employment opportunities were evaluated as excellent or good by 3 in 10 residents, which increased approximately 15% since 2017. However, Nevada County residents identified affordability as a growing concern, which is a finding reflected in ongoing national trends. Roughly 2 in 10 respondents offered favorable ratings to the cost of living in Nevada County, decreasing since 2017. The availability of affordable quality food also trended downward, garnering positive reviews from about half. A lower proportion gave high marks to the availability of affordable quality health care (31% excellent or good), availability of affordable quality mental health care (25%), and availability of affordable quality childcare/preschool (31%), all of which declined by at least 15% since the previous survey. The availability of affordable quality housing was viewed positively by only 10% of respondents. In a custom question posed by Nevada County, 9 in 10 participants supported development of income-based affordable housing and development of workforce housing, while housing for individuals experiencing homelessness garnered support from about 8 in 10.

The county's natural environment and parks and recreational opportunities remain highly valued by residents.


About 9 in 10 residents identified the natural environment as an essential or very important area of focus for the community in the next two years, landing in the top three priorities identified by residents. A similar proportion of survey participants praised the overall quality of the natural environment and the county's water resources, which were both higher than the national benchmarks. In addition, ratings for the county's recreational opportunities (87% excellent or good) surpassed the national average. Air quality was also highly regarded by roughly 8 in 10 residents, in line with counterparts nationwide. The availability of paths and walking trails received favorable evaluations from 84% of respondents, compared to 71% in 2017. About three-quarters of respondents appreciated county parks, open space, and recreation programs or classes. Recreation centers or facilities and the preservation of natural areas were both valued by approximately two-thirds. Although most evaluations in these facets were strong, an area of opportunity emerged: reviews for recycling services saw a steep decline from 2017, decreasing from 73% excellent or good to 52%, which may merit additional research.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation.

The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).


Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide County staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.


Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 66% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 66% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 76% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 76%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.




Quality of life

Measuring community livability starts with assessing the quality of life of those who live there, and ensuring that the community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.




Please rate each of the following aspects of quality of life in Nevada County. (% excellent or good)







Overall design or layout of Nevada County's residential and commercial areas, 2023











Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community SurveyTM (The NCSTM), Nevada County conducted a survey of 518 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from September 12th, 2023 to October 24th, 2023. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by Nevada County. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all county residents and became available on October 10th, 2023. The survey remained open for two weeks and there were 1,239 responses.


The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2020 Census and 2022 American Community Survey estimates for adults in Nevada County. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, housing tenure, and area. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.
