**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving the 2026 Truckee Fuel Break Good Neighbor Agreement (FS Agreement No. 26-GN-11051700-XXX) between the USDA Forest Services, Tahoe National Forest, and the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$604,750 with \$345,000 in match funds for use through 12/30/2035, authorizing the Director of Emergency Services to execute the agreement and all additional documents to fulfill the requirements of the agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada and directing the Auditor Controller to amend the fiscal year 2026-27 Office of Emergency Services budget (4/5 Affirmative vote required)

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** Grant funds in the amount of \$604,750 will be provided via reimbursement from USDA Forest Service. \$345,000 match funds will be provided by Truckee Fire Protection District. A budget amendment for the Office of Emergency Services Fiscal Year 2026-27 Budget has been included to acknowledge the revenue and expenses related to the agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** The County of Nevada Office of Emergency Services (OES) and the Tahoe National Forest (TNF) have a vested interest in supporting wildfire resilient communities and landscapes in Nevada County. By previous action of the Board, Resolution 24-411 and Resolution 25-031 authorized the Director of Emergency Services to execute two Good Neighbor Agreements (GNAs) between the USDA Forest Service, TNF and the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services (OES) to increase the pace and scale of wildfire mitigation efforts.

The location of 2026 Truckee Fuel Break Good Neighbor Agreement project area is consistent with the highest priority areas for treatment in the Truckee Fire Protection

District's (TFPD) Community Wildfire Protection Plan and USFS priorities established by the Middle Truckee River Forest Watershed Partnership and is located on non-federal land near the Tahoe National Forest and the Town of Truckee.

The Truckee Fire Protection District will provide the \$345,000 in project match and will oversee the execution of this project. OES will return to the Board of Supervisors for approval of an agreement to work with Truckee Fire Protection District on this project.
