SUBJECT: Resolution accepting the Authorization/Agreement Summary (E-76) authorizing funding for the construction phase in the amount of \$1,304,746 for Federal Aid Project Number 5917(119), Combie Road Multi-Use Trail Project – District II.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

FUNDING: The Combie Road Multi-Use Trail Project is funded with Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program funds. This project is in the current Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Plan and impacts Fiscal Year 24/25 Road Engineering Budget. A budget amendment is not required and there is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Combie Road Multi-Use Trail Project will build a new path along the north side of Combie Road between Higgins Road and W Hacienda Drive and will provide a safe access from the existing pedestrian facility at the Combie/West Hacienda intersection to the Higgins area developments.

The State has prepared an Authorization/Agreement Summary (E-76), dated September 23, 2024, authorizing an award amount of \$1,304,746 for the Construction phase for a total amount of \$1,304,746. Approval from the Board of Supervisors is required to accept these funds. Project construction anticipated spring 2025.
