OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF THE EXISTING MILITARY EQUIPMENT USE POLICY AS CALLED FOR IN AB 481 AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE ANNUAL REPORT AND SUBSEQUENT PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT MEETING REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2022, AB 481 came into effect adding Chapter 12.8 to Division 7 of Title 1 (commencing with Section 7070) to the Government Code. These requirements called for the establishment of an Ordinance requiring law enforcement agencies to develop a policy, provide a list of equipment and obtain approval of their governing body, prior to requesting, seeking, or using 'military equipment' either permanently or temporarily; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to AB 481, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office prepared a Military Equipment Use Policy ("MEUP") which was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada on April 26, 2022 per Ordinance 2508; and

WHEREAS, the MEUP attached hereto, must be submitted to the Board of Supervisors annually for approval; and

WHEREAS, AB 481 requires the Sheriff's Office to submit to the governing body an annual Military Equipment Use ("MEU") report; and

WHEREAS, should the MEUP and annual MEU report be approved, AB 481 requires the MEU annual report attached hereto, to be published to the Sheriff's Office website for at least 30 days prior to holding a well-publicized community engagement meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, of the County of Nevada, State of California, on behalf of the County of Nevada, approve the attached Military Equipment Use Policy and MEU Annual Report.
