OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH PROJECT H.E.A.R.T. INC. TO PROVIDE PEER MENTORING, PEER COACHING AND PRO-SOCIAL GROUP RELATIONSHIP SERVICES FOR CURRENT AND FORMER ADULT PROBATION CLIENTS DURING FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017

WHEREAS, in 2014 the Probation Department was awarded Federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration (SAMHSA) grant to expand treatment services and programs to adults; and

WHEREAS, SAMHSA promotes Peer Recovery Support Services to prevent relapse and promote sustained recovery; and

WHEREAS, Project H.E.A.R.T. provides mentoring and coaching services in alignment with SAMHSA's Peer Recovery Support Services recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Probation Officer desires to extend Project H.E.A.R.T. services to adults who are currently, or were in the past, on probation; and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into a Personal Services Contract dated July 14, 2015 which is set to expire on June 30, 2016 adopted by resolution 15-318.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the County of Nevada, that certain Personal Services Contract dated the 1ST day of July, 2016, by and between said county and Project H.E.A.R.T. Inc. pertaining to providing a program of peer mentoring, peer coaching and pro-social group relationship services for current and former adult probation clients in their recovery from alcohol/drug dependency and related involvement with the criminal justice system. All services are funded by the SAMHSA grant, State Community Corrections Performance funds (SB678) and State Local Community Corrections Account apportionment (AB109) for the contract term of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

Funds to be disbursed from 0101-20320-201-1000 / 521520 not to exceed the maximum contract amount of \$45,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Auditor-Controller to encumber \$45,000 for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.
