## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PERSONAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH GATEWAY MOUNTAIN CENTER FOR THE PROVISION OF SPECIALTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PRIMARILY TARGETED FOR EMOTIONALLY DISTURBED YOUTH TO AMEND EXHIBIT "A" SCHEDULE OF SERVICES TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL REPORTING AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO MANDATED REPORTING OF CHILD AND DEPENDENT ADULT ABUSE/NEGLECT, INCIDENT/COMPLAINT AND INVESTIGATION REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES, AND BACKGROUND CHECK PROCEDURES ON EMPLOYEES AND OTHERS HAVING CONTACT WITH YOUTH UNDER THE AGREEMENT FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020 (RES. 19-470)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved a renewal contract with Gateway Mountain Center to provide Specialty Mental Health Services primarily targeted for emotionally disturbed youth on August 27, 2019 per Resolution 19-470; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their agreement to amend Exhibit "A" Schedule of Services to include additional provisions that (1) specify mandated reporting roles and responsibilities on behalf of the Contractor and its employees, (2) outline Contractor's notification requirements to County pertaining to incidents involving County-referred clients, including any investigations or lawsuits against Contractor, and (3) detail specific background checks and hiring procedures on those individuals having contact with clients.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that Amendment No. 1 to the Personal Services Contract by and between the County of Nevada and Gateway Mountain Center pertaining to the provision of Comprehensive Specialty Mental Health Services primarily targeted for emotionally disturbed youth to amend Exhibit "A" Schedule of Services to include additional provisions that (1) specify mandated reporting roles and responsibilities on behalf of the Contractor and its employees, (2) outline Contractor's notification requirements to County pertaining to incidents involving County-referred clients, including any investigations or lawsuits against Contractor, and (3) detail specific background checks and hiring procedures on those individuals having contact with clients, for the term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 be and hereby is approved, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment on behalf of the County of Nevada.
