



RESOLUTION No. 18-496

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCE RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) GRANT FUNDING FOR \$50,000

WHEREAS, The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) grant is a competitive grant made available by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle); and

WHEREAS, these monies are designated to help local governments establish or expand HHW collection programs; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 17-118 authorized the Department of Public Works to apply for available grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the request for 2018/19 HHW Grant funding was made in March, 2018 in the amount of \$50,000 and the funds have been awarded to Nevada County and are now available for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, funds must be expended by the end of the grant term, September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to establish retail locations in Nevada County to sell, refill and/or exchange refillable 11b propane cylinders and conduct an outreach and education campaign to encourage the use of refillables and promote the safe disposal of standard disposable propane cylinders; and

WHEREAS, when funds are reimbursed from the State they will be deposited into: 0101-40402-705-1000 445205

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to accept the \$50,000 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) grant received through the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle).
2. Authorizes the Director of the Department of Public Works to execute additional documents, as necessary, to implement this grant.
